# How Can You Participate?

All current team members are eligible to enroll during the open enrollment period. New team members are eligible to enroll after a 30 day waiting period. Dependents to include spouses, and children and stepchildren under the age of 26, are also eligible during open enrollment for current team members or after the initial waiting period for newly hired team members.

## How Are Premium Payments Made?

Premiums are to be paid through auto bank draft (ACH), or by credit or debit card. Payments will be drafted **20th** day of each month. If you miss a payment, vour insurance will be terminated and vou will not be eligible to re-enroll until the next open enrollment period.

# What if I do not enroll?

Benefits are being offered to you during an open enrollment period. If you do not enroll in benefits during this open enrollment, you will be unable to enroll in benefits until the next open enrollment period unless you experience a qualifying change in status. Newly hired team members must enroll for benefits within the first 30 days of becoming eligible. If you are a newly hired team member and vou do not enroll within the first 30 days of becoming eligible, you will not be able to enroll until the next open enrollment period, unless you experience a qualifying change in status.

## Can I Sign Up For Insurance At Any Time?

No. You must enroll during the open enrollment period. Newly hired team members must enroll for benefits within the first 30 days of becoming eligible. If you are a newly hired team member and you do not enroll within the first 30 days of becoming eligible, you will not be able to enroll until the next open enrollment period, unless you experience a qualifying change in status.

## Can I Cancel My Insurance At Any Time?

Yes. However, if you cancel your insurance, you will not be able to re-enroll until the next open enrollment period, unless you have a gualifying change in status.
